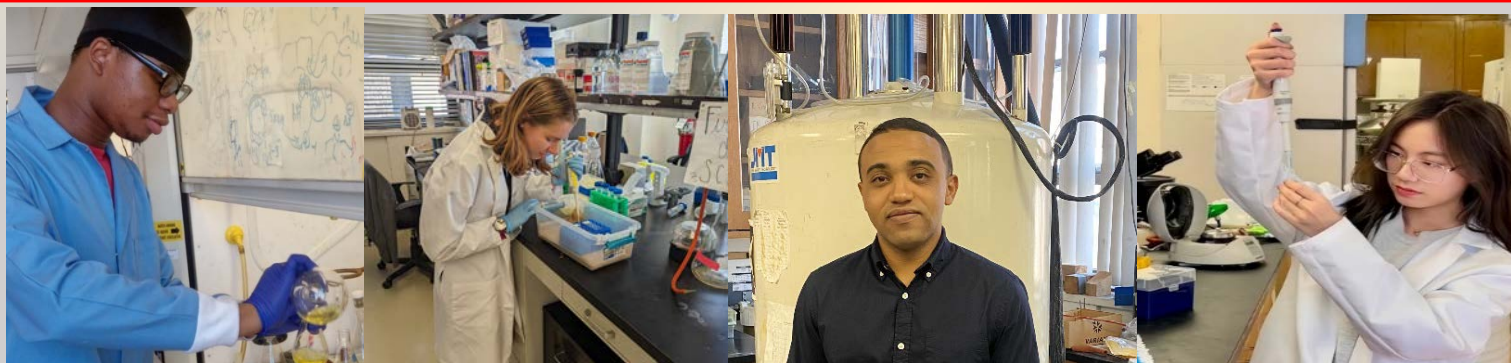


MARC SCHOLARS at HUNTER

MARC program provides year-round research training for undergraduate underrepresented students at Hunter. The program's aim is to prepare MARC scholars for admissions acceptance to biomedical graduate research programs in PhD or combined MD/PhD degree. (MARC is funded by NIH)



Scholars receive:

- Hands on research & Lab exposure
- Career Development Training
- Support systems / Hunter faculty research mentor & student alliances
- Skill building in critical thinking and scientific writing/presenting
- Exposure to career scientists and grad recruiters
- Resources for summer/graduate programs
- Attend a national scientific conference and network

Monthly stipend for participating in MARC activities, 15 - 20 hours per week (academic year) and summer fulltime conducting research
